Revelation 12:7–11

We overcame Satan “by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of [our] testimony.”

- *Read JST, Revelation 12:7-11*
- *How did we overcome Satan and his hosts in the war in Heaven?*
- *How can this help us overcome the adversary during our mortal lives?*
- *What does it mean: “The lamb was slain from the foundation of the world”?*
 - *Revelation 13:8 & 5:6*
- *What does it mean to overcome Satan by the blood of the lamb?*

We must separate ourselves from the wickedness of the world.
