Mosiah 11-13; 17

I can stand for truth, even when I stand alone.

- o Have you ever felt like you were standing alone in defense of truth?
- o What do you learn in Mosiah 11-13 and 17?
- o What do you learn that can help you be ready when the Lord needs you to stand up for His gospel?
- o What other principles do you learn from Abinadi's example?

Mosiah 12:19-30

I need to apply my heart to understanding God's word.

- o King Noah's priests were familiar with the word of God—they could quote passages of scripture and claimed to teach the commandments. But those commandments were "not written in their hearts" what does this mean? Mosiah 13:11, 12:27
- o What was the result of them not having the commandments written in their hearts?
- o What does it mean to apply your heart to understanding God's word? Mosiah 12:19-30
- o Does this inspire you to make any changes in the way you approach learning the gospel?

Mosiah 13:1-9

The Lord will sustain His servants in His work.

- o How does Abinadi's experience give examples of how the Lord supports His servants? Mosiah 13:1-9
- o The Lord also allowed Abinadi to be persecuted, imprisoned, and martyred for his testimony. What do you find in these verses that reveals that Abinadi trusted the Lord?
- o How does Abinadi's example affect the way you view your callings and responsibilities?

Mosiah 14-15

Jesus Christ suffered for me.

- What do you learn about the Savior and what he suffered in Mosiah 14-15
- What verses help deepen your love and gratitude towards Him?

Mosiah 15:1-12

How is Jesus Christ both the Father and the Son?

- How is Jesus Christ both the Father and the Son? We know that they are separate beings? What did Abinadi mean? Mosiah 15:1
- What did Abinadi say would happen in Mosiah 15:2-3
- What would Jesus do for us? 15:5-9
- Because of these things Jesus Christ is both the Son of God and the perfect earthly representation of God the Father John 14:6-10
- How did Abinadi explain that Jesus Christ is also like a Father? Mosiah 15:11-12
- Who do we become spiritually reborn through? Mosiah 5:7
